Activities

Participation in archaeological excavation activities authorized by the Historical Heritage Department of the Autonomous Government and developed within several research projects of the State Plan of R & D & I of the Government of Spain / Feder (Garvm III) and the Andalusian autonomous government (Arqueofish and Arqueostra), led by the HUM-440 Research Group of the University of Cádiz. Consisting of the execution of stratigraphic surveys and active collaboration with researchers in the integral process of registration and documentation, written and graphic, as well as in the preliminary analysis of the material culture that appeared (Roman times, 1st - 5th centuries AD).

Selection criteria:

B1 level in English is required, basic Spanish advisable. Specialised training in archeology (PhD, Master, Degree, 50%) and curricular merits related to the profession (50%).

Logistics:

The archaeological activities will take place at the Baelo Claudia site from 7:30 am to 3:00 pm, with each student having a tutor. Afternoons (except for one per week) and weekends are free. Accommodation, maintenance and accident insurance, as well as travel costs (up to 500€) will be covered by SEA - EU, being 3 weeks at the University of Cádiz residence. Participants will receive an official certificate of participation for 150 hours. They will have to comply with current regulations on health prevention against the Covid-19 pandemic.
