Other instructions:

- Title of the paper should be written in large bold letters (font 14, centralized).
- Authors names should be written in bold letters (font 12, centralized).
- Name of the affiliation and contact details should be written in italic, font 12 (centralized).
- Papers need to be formatted for printing on 210 x 297 mm paper.
- Spacing should be 1.5. Side margins (left, right, top and bottom) should be set to 25 mm.
- The text must be aligned with left and right margins (aligned on both sides).
- The paper should have maximum of 5000 and words (without literature).
- APA format citation and reference style should be used (with author's last name and the year of publication for the source that appears in the text. For example, (Jones, 1998). Also, complete reference for each source should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.
- Above the tables, figures, graphs and other representations, the name is of the table, figure and graph should be written, and below them, the source is stated using the number of the table, figure, graphs (for example. Table 1, Figure 1, Graph 1).
- Line spacing options: single spacing 1,0.

All other titles and subtitles are written in small bold letters and indicated by numbers as follows (after a selection there should be one empty row of space:
