The intensive course offers an in-depth analysis of Shakespeare's work, with a particular emphasis on its impact on contemporary European culture. It focuses on theoretical analysis of texts but also on contemporary interpretations. The course is carried out in cooperation with Performing Arts Division, Institute of English and American Studies, at the University of Gdańsk and in partnership with The Gdańsk Shakespeare Theatre. At the end of the course students will have a chance to participate as actors in a short piece of the performance.

TARGET STUDENTS

The initiative is designed for students who are interested in performing arts or cultural studies. Participants will be awarded 2 ECTS points.

PROGRAMME

The course will take place physically in Gdańsk and will last 5 days. Program focuses on Shakespeare – his texts, his times, sources and influences. By taking part in the course, students will have the opportunity to deepen their knowledge about work of this great author, whose texts lie at the heart of European cultural identity. We offer a broad spectrum of perspectives through lectures, acting classes, drama-based workshops, theatre and dance improvisation workshops and also visit to The Gdańsk Shakespeare Theatre.

REGISTRATION

The limit is 4 students per SEA-EU University. The course will be filled on a first-come-first-served-basis. Register until April 1.
