- Tasks and duties entrusted to the student:

The aim of this internship is that students are integrated into real work settings, performing over a period several tasks that will help them gain professional experience.

As a final product, it is expected that students are able to publicly present their internship report. Skills to be acquired or developed:

- a) understand the culture, philosophy and principles of host institutions;
- b) identify and understand the rules, procedures, and attitudes characteristic of the work contexts ;
- c) concretise in work contexts the knowledge and skills previously acquired;
- d) promote a reflection on the processes and learning acquired during the internship;
- e) collect original information about a problem using research methods and techniques;
- f) prepare a diagnosis in the work context;
- g) analyse the results and draw relevant conclusions.

- Minimum level of study required: bachelor.

- Scientific skills: the student must demonstrate capacity to learn and adapt to different contexts, analytic and communication skills, teamwork, self-discipline and respect ethics.
