Become a UBO Research Ambassador in the SEA-EU Alliance

RULES

1. Context and objectives

The ResEArch-AmbassadEUrs initiative is part of the SEA-EU European alliance and aims to:

- Support individual research projects led by researchers and teacher-researchers at UBO.
- Encourage the initiation of new scientific collaborations.
- Strengthen the European dimension of research at UBO.
- Promote research results through short-term international mobility.
- Contribute to the strategic objectives of the ReSEArch_EU project and to the visibility of UBO research within the SEA-EU alliance.

Each mobility will result in:

- A mobility report (2 to 4 pages) including the results obtained.
- Availability for communication activities (written, audio, or video interviews).

2. Amount and distribution of funding

- Each selected applicant will receive a **lump sum mobility grant of €3,000.**
- This amount covers: transportation, accommodation, and meals, either in full or in cofinancing with the home laboratory.
- Erasmus+ funding is not eligible.
- Funding is awarded for up to 40 supported mobility projects.
- Mobility must be completed before November 1, 2026.
- Expenses must be justified in accordance with ANR funding rules.

Any publication resulting from the project must include the following statement:

"This project received government funding managed by the National Research Agency under the Investments for the Future program – Reference ANR-19-GURE-0001."

3. Eligibility criteria

Applications are open to:

 Researchers and acamedic staff engaged in both teaching and research, with a permanent or long-term contract, who are members of a UBO research unit (or for which UBO is one of the tutelles).

Mobility must:

- Include short stays (maximum 10 days) at three SEA-EU partner universities.
- Be carried out in a single trip as far as possible, to reduce the carbon footprint.
- Include a presentation of the work at each partner university.

























• Be accompanied by letters of commitment from the three partner universities (template provided).

Priority given to:

- New collaborations
- Young researchers
- Applicants who have never received SEA-EU funding

4. Application and selection procedures

Submission of the file

Applicants must submit a single PDF file to: contact-sea-eu@univ-brest.fr

Subject of the email: 2025 ReSEArch-AmbassadEUrs

The application must include:

- 1. The completed application form (in English) downloadable from the website
- 2. A link to an updated CV (in English, online)
- 3. Signed letters of commitment from the three partner universities (template provided)
- 4. Applicants are required to read the rules and regulations beforehand

Project evaluation

Applications will be reviewed by two members of the UBO Research Council based on the following criteria:

- Consistency of the mobility schedule (preference for a single trip, reduction of carbon footprint).
- Quality and complementarity of European partnerships
- Potential for developing collaborations for the UBO laboratory in the short and long term.
- Quality of the on-site program (planned activities, contacts, etc.).
- Innovativeness of collaborations.
- Alignment with the SEA-EU project's focus areas and the ReSEArch_EU strategic agenda:
 SEA-EU research plan
- · Overall quality of the application.

5. Terms and conditions for the use of funding

The granted funding may be used exclusively for:

Mission expenses related to mobility: transportation, accommodation, and meals.

The following are not eligible:

- · Salaries, even partial ones
- The purchase of computer equipment (office automation)
- Erasmus+ funding
- Expenses incurred for entities outside the University of Brest

Selected applicants agree to:

- Submit within 30 days of the results:
 - A presentation slide (PDF)
 - o A **summary of the project** (10 lines max.) in French and English
- Produce a final **mobility report** (2 to 4 pages)
- Be available for **interviews** (audio, video, or written)
- Be an SEA-EU ambassador:
 - o Promote the alliance to colleagues and students
 - Use the SEA-EU logo in presentations related to the project
