

Annex 8. Specific Requirements for English Language Proficiency

Knowledge of the English language is considered as a basic requirement to follow classes.

To access the Master, all students will be asked to provide a proof of sufficient knowledge of the English language through one of the following documents:

- A TOEFL Certificate: minimum global score: 570 points (paper), 72 points (iBT)
- A TOEIC Certificate: minimum global score: 785 points
- A IELTS Certificate (in person or online): minimum score: 5.5
- A Certificate of a University Language Centre testifying that the student masters the necessary knowledge of English to function academically (specify CEF-level / minimum CEF-level B2)
- A B2 First (former names: Cambridge English First or First Certificate in English): minimum score: grade C
- A Pearson PTE Academic: minimum score: 59
- A CLES Certificate – Level B2
- A certificate proving that the student has followed at least 1 year of higher education in English

The STORM Programme Management Board (PMB) can, at its own discretion, waive the requirement for proof of English language skills if English was the official language of instruction/teaching for at least one year of the previous successful Higher Education studies.
